

Traffic regulations for Jomon-sugi Arakawa Route

Traffic on Arakawa Route is regulated all day to reduce the environmental burden and to control excessive car traffic going into the mountains. Please follow the regulations for a more enjoyable and safe trip.

[Regulation period] From March 1 to November 30 (275 days)

[Regulation time] 24 hours (Arakawa san-saro's gate operation)

[Regulation zone] From the gate at the Arakawa san-saro to Arakawa tozan-guchi

Please purchase the Arakawa Mountain Bus ticket in advance. A donation for the Yakushima's Mountain Environmental Conservation program is greatly appreciated.

Users of the local bus, car, rent a car, moterbike, or bicycle

▶ need to take the Arakawa Mountain Bus in front of Yakusugi Museum.

Route: Yakusugi Museum bus stop-Arakawa Tozanguchi

Junior high school students and up	[One-way] 1,690 yen or 2,690 yen (690 yen per ticket + donation*) [Round trip] 2,380 yen or 3,380 yen (1,380 yen for two one-way tickets + donation*) *Minimal donation for a day is 1,000 yen and minimal donation for more than one day is 2,000 yen.
Elementary school students	[One-way] 350 yen (per ticket) [Round trip] 700 yen (for two one-way tickets)

We ask you to purchase the Arakawa Mountain Bus tickets in advance. If you don't have a ticket on that day, you can purchase one at Yakushima Mountain Environmental Council Office in front of the Yakusugi Museum bus stop, but you may not be able to take the early bus.

Chartered bus and taxi users

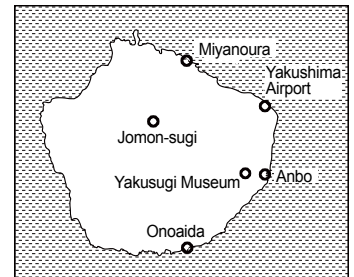
▶ A donation for the Yakushima's Mountain Environmental Conservation program is greatly appreciated.

There are local buses operating from Yakusugi Museum to Miyanoura and to Onoaida. Please check the local bus timetable to connect with Arakawa Mountain Bus.

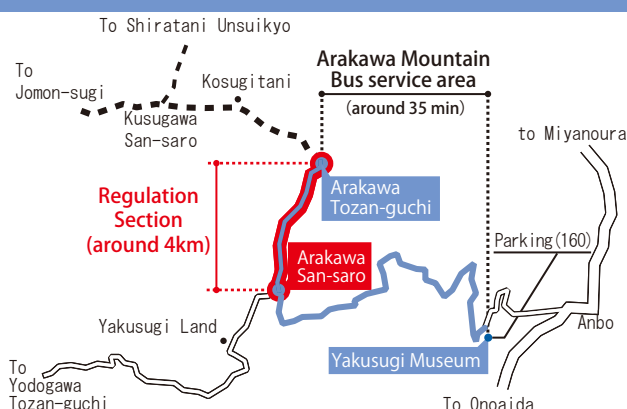
