Message from Yakushima

- National government cancellation of the novel coronavirus emergency declaration on May 25, 2020

On behalf of the people of Yakushima, I would like to send our deepest sympathy and condolences to the victims of the novel coronavirus and to their bereaved family. I also would like to express our heartfelt sympathy to all those who were inconvenienced by the novel coronavirus emergency declaration.

Knowing that many tourist businesses would be affected, asking people to refrain from visiting or traveling to Yakushima during the period of the novel coronavirus emergency was a tough decision we had to make.

The main reason for making this decision was for the protection of human lives and their health. A secondary reason was our medical care facilities would not be able to handle an outbreak of novel coronavirus.

Thanks to the cooperation of the people and local businesses, Yakushima had no novel coronavirus outbreak.

Many shop owners and businesses were greatly affected by the loss of customers. Following the announcement of the national government complete cancellation of the emergency declaration, we would like to gradually resume the economic activities on Yakushima. But we would also like shop owners and businesses to continue with the countermeasures against the novel coronavirus.

Although the limit of traveling or visiting across prefectures will remain in effect, Yakushima Town Office has decided to open all municipal tourist spots/facilities on Yakushima from June 1st. We will still be implementing all countermeasures against novel coronavirus.

Yakushima Town Office will be setting up measures to support local businesses.

When all travel bans across prefectures are lifted, we will issue gift certificates as a part of a tourism campaign to revitalize tourism on Yakushima.

To the potential visitors from Kagoshima

In order to prevent the novel coronavirus infections, please cooperate with the following measures (the Infectious Spreading Prevention Practice).

- 1. Visitors who have a fever, who feel ill or have novel coronavirus-like symptoms and who have traveled across the Prefectural border within 2 weeks are strongly requested to refrain from visiting.
- 2. Please cooperate with having your temperature checked at ports and/or airports.
- 3. Please make sure to wash your hands, gargle, and wear masks to prevent infection. (Bringing some sanitizing goods like hand Sanitizers are also recommended.)
- 4. Please avoid CLOSED-IN SPACES, CROWEDED PLACES, CLOSE-CONTACTS, keep physical distance from one another.
- 5. Please keep a record of your movements, as much as possible, in case you get infected.

We are looking forward to having the people of Kagoshima visiting Yakushima again. However, we would like you to follow the Infectious Spreading Prevention Practice.
