## To Potential Visitors to Yakushima

(Request to cooperate with countermeasures against the COVID-19 during the spring transfer season)

On March 21, the state of emergency for Tokyo and three neighboring prefectures was lifted.

Spring, on the other hand, is a time of year when there are more risks of COVID-19 contamination, such as transferring and dining.

Although the novel coronavirus emergency declaration was canceled, we will continue to implement all countermeasures against novel coronavirus. We also believe it is important to share information and experiences about the COVID-19 infections.

If the COVID-19 infections occurred in Yakushima, our regional medical care facilities would be overwhelmed making medical care difficult.

In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19, we would like for all potential visitors to cooperate with the following requests.

Please take good care of yourself before your visit about two weeks. Avoid CLOSED-IN SPACES, CROWDED PLACES, CLOSE-CONTACTS.
▶ If you don't feel well, please postpone or cancel your visit.
▶ Please make sure to wear masks, use hand sanitizers, and keep your distances from one another.
► The use of COVID-19 Contact-Confirming Application (COCOA) on your smartphone is recommended.

Anyone could get infected with COVID-19 at any time.

In order not to contract COVID-19 and infect other people, I would like for you to continue with the countermeasures against COVID-19.
